

RESOLUTION 2018-638

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ASOTIN ACCEPTING THE COMPLETION AND SATISFACTION OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE PROJECT PROVIDED BY USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, In June 2014, the City of Asotin received grant funding through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA); and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2014-529 on June 23, 2014 authorizing the City of Asotin to accept the design and construction of the Submersible Pump Station, Aerators and DO Control, and Grit System as well as the UV Bank improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Asotin has received all of the O&M manuals; and

WHEREAS, the Waste Water Treatment Plant work has been completed, is fully operational and the City Council is satisfied with the project and wishes to close out this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Asotin, Washington, passed Resolution 2014-529 on June 23, 2014 authorizing the City of Asotin to accept the design and construction of the Submersible Pump Station, Aerators and DO Control, and Grit System as well as the UV Bank improvements. The City of Asotin has received all of the O&M manuals.
