Approved consumer fireworks, as defined by RCW 70.77.136, may be discharged during the following times and dates:

July 3rd between the hours of 9:00 am to 11:00 pm

July 4th between the hours of 9:00 am to 12:00 midnight

Correction Regarding Fireworks Discharge Times and Fire Safety Regulations in Asotin

The City of Asotin wishes to clarify and correct previous information regarding the permitted times for the discharge of consumer fireworks within the city limits. The sale date and times were inadvertently used for discharge times.

The correct discharge times for authorized consumer fireworks defined by RCW 70.77.136, are as follows:

- Consumer fireworks may be discharged within Asotin only between **9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on July 3rd.**
- **9:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on July 4th.**

Please note that a **burn ban** was enacted beginning at **6:00 a.m. on July 5th.** Under this ban, fires, open burning, and all fireworks are **illegal** and strictly prohibited to prevent wildfires and ensure community safety. Approved propane fire rings, approved propane and charcoal barbeques are allowed.

Safety Reminder:

Given the current extreme dryness of the area, the risk of fire is significantly heightened. Fireworks should only be used during the permitted times and in designated areas, and always with extreme caution. It is imperative that residents remain vigilant and immediately report any signs of fire to local authorities.

We urge all community members to prioritize safety and adhere to the established regulations. The ongoing fire risk underscores the importance of responsible fireworks use and respecting the burn ban to prevent dangerous wildfires.
